## **Rules and Regulations of Competition.**

Rules of Competition	The competition will be run under the rules of FEI and rules of <b>Equestrian</b> <b>Australia and Equestrian Association of Malaysia (EAM).</b> All riders receive prizes must be mounted.			
Prize Giving Ceremony	Show jumping placed riders that do not attend the prize giving ceremony will not receive their prizes. All riders must be mounted during prize giving.			
In House-Rules	<ul> <li>All riders are expected to wear a correctly fastened and fitted hard hat, riding boots and shirt at all times when mounted.</li> <li>The competition grounds and stable area must be kept clean and tidy at all times.</li> <li>Washing down horses should be done in the washing bays only not inside the stables.</li> <li>You are provided with bags for the disposal of dung and other refuse. The dung / waste must be removed from the sawdust daily and disposed of in the correct manner.</li> <li>Stabling is limited and will be on a first paid first served basis. All stabling must be left in a clean tidy state otherwise a charge will be levied.</li> </ul>			
The Organizer Reserves The Right To	Bill any participating club the cost of cleaning stables. Alter advertised times if necessary. Cancel any event or class. Divide any class.			
Grading System	Refuse any entries. Application for up / down grading must be made to the EAM before entries closing date.			
Veterinary Scratching	Entries cancelled after the Entries closing Date must be verified with a Vet. medical Certificate for a 50% refund of the entry fee, provided that the cancellation is done before the commencement of any event.			
Waiver Forms and Acknowledgement Forms	Please return all waiver and acknowledgement forms by Entries Closing Date. Competitors without signed forms will not be allowed to compete. The waiver and acknowledgement forms are attached as <b>Appendix 3</b> .			
Competition Ground	Outdoor Arena/ Grass			
Horse Passport / Vaccination Certificate	Passport must be available upon entry in to the showground. It is mandatory for the horses / ponies competing to be inoculated against Equine Influenza and Japanese B Virus. The medical record must indicate proper inoculations and clearance. If this conditions are not complied it; the horses / ponies will be denied access to the showground and competition.			

Entry Fees	All entry fees must be paid prior to the start the competition double. Late entry will be charged double. No return will be made for rider without or cancel the entry without Veterinary Scratching.				
Tent Pegging	The tent pegging competition will organised in 6 runs ie: 2 run- on lance , 2 run on sword, 2 run on sword lemon cutting and peg.				
	Classification will be the total score of the 6 runs.				
	Time allowed : Lance & Sword - 7.00 sec Sward lemon and ring - 7.5 sec				
Medical Control Programmer	The executive committee of Equestrian Association of Malaysia (EAM) has decided that Usains Boimics Laboratory Services Sdn Bhd is the official laboratory to test all Equine Anti Doping in the National level. The participants refuse to allow their horses to be tested will be disqualified.				
CSI1* Classes	For CSI1* classes – all horses and riders must register with FEI and process of FEI ID number.				
	All CSI1* horses, riders must download FEI App Horse and update the horses temperature 3 days before competition until horses leave the competition stable. Those who do not update in the FEI App Horse may be fine and suspend from FEI competition.				
	All CSI1* entry must be sent to EAM office before 08/05/2023.
