B. Entries Closing Date

All entries must be made using the prescribed forms attached. Entries must reach the Organizer's

Address above by the **28 April 2025.** Entries received after the above dates will be considered as Late Entries. Entries and booking of stables may be made in person, by post, fax or via internet and will be confirmed when full payment is received.

All entries received after the closing date will be charged an additional 50% unless stated in the schedule.

E. Rules and Regulations of Competition

The competition will be run under the rules of FEI and rules of **Equestrian Australia Federation and Equestrian Association of Malaysia (EAM)**. All riders receive prizes must be mounted.

Competition Ground

The Organizer Reserves The Right To

Bill any participating club the cost of cleaning stables. Alter advertised times if necessary. Cancel any event or class. Divide any class. Refuse any entries.

In House-Rules

All riders are expected to wear a correctly fastened and fitted hard hat, riding boots and shirt at all times when mounted. The competition grounds and stable area must be kept clean and tidy at all times. Washing down horses should be done in the washing bays only not inside the stables. You are provided with bags for the disposal of dung and other refuse. The dung/waste must be removed from the sawdust daily and disposed of in the correct manner. Stabling is limited and will be on a first paid first served basis. All stabling must be left in a clean tidy state otherwise a charge will be levied.

Grading System

Application for up / down grading must be made to the EAM before entries closing date.

Prize Giving Ceremony

Show jumping placed riders that do not attend the prize giving ceremony will not receive their prizes. All riders must be mounted during prize giving.

Entry Fees

All entry fees and stable fee must be paid prior to the start the competition.

Late entry will be charged double. No refund will be made for riders without or cancel the entry without veterinary certificate.

CSI1* Classes

For CSI1* classes – all horses and riders must register with FEI and process of FEI ID number. All CSI1* horses, riders must download FEI App Horse and update the horses temperature 3 days before competition until horses leave the competition stable. Those who do not update in the FEI App Horse may be fine and suspend from FEI competition.

Stable

All horses and national horses will stables at temporary stable. No refund for the stable fee and will be changed if do not turn up. The size of stable temporary is (3.3m x 3.3m) approval by FEI.

Waiver Forms and Acknowledgement Forms

Please return all waiver and acknowledgement forms by Entries Closing Date. Competitors without signed forms will not be allowed to compete. The waiver and acknowledgement forms are attached as *Appendix 3.*

Horse Passport / Vaccination Certificate

Passport must be available upon entry in to the showground. It is mandatory for the horses / ponies competing to be inoculated against Equine Influenza and Japanese B Virus. The medical record must indicate proper inoculations and clearance. If this conditions are not complied it; the horses / ponies will be denied access to the showground and competition.

Veterinary Scratching

Entries canceled after the Entries closing Date must be verified with a Veterinary medical Certificate for a 50% refund of the entry fee, provided that the cancellation is done before the commencement of any event.

Jumping Event (Class40-60cm)

This class 40-60cm open to the riders and horses that never compete in the jumping competition. Those combination (horse and rider) had participated at 80cm and above from January 2024 are not allow to participate in this class

Team Competition

Compete under article 238.2.1, three (3) riders per team to count for ranking. The eliminated rider receive 20 penalty points from the riders penalty worst of the round.

Body Protector Jumping

Those riders under the age of 16yo from January 2024 is compulsory to wear body protector during warm up and competition.

Enter and compete in no more than 3 tests in same day.

From Preliminary level and above, there will be no sharing of horses at official EAM Competitions.

Must only enter and compete in two consecutive levels per event from the current grading; graded Prelim - can enter Prelim and Novice or Novice and Elementary. Graded Novice - can enter Novice and Elementary or Elementary and Medium.

Prize money only awarded to the riders score with 60% and above.

Medical Control Programme

The executive committee of Equestrian Association of Malaysia (EAM) has decided that Usains Boimics Laboratory Services Sdn Bhd is the official laboratory to test all Equine Anti-Doping in the National level. The participants refuse to allow their horses to be tested will be disqualified and discipline action will be taken.

A horse subjected to MCP must follow the instruction and escorted by the steward to the MCP box. Any objection for MCP test will penalize by the Organizer, National Federation and Federation Equestre Internationale.

Electrical

For the fire fire prevention and safety, no extension of cable, plug point and electrical equipment by horse owner without approval from OC. All additional plug and electrical extension must be approved and carried out by the license electricians.

Insurance

All participants must have personal accident insurance and third party liability insurance.
