B. ENTRIES CLOSING DATE

All entries must be made using the prescribed forms attached. Entries must reach the Organizer's

Address above by the **9 October 2025.** Entries received after the above dates will be considered as Late Entries. Entries and booking of stables may be made in person, by post, fax or via internet and will be confirmed when full payment is received.

All entries received after the closing date will be charged an additional 50% unless stated in the schedule.

C. ENTRY FORMS

All entries are to be on the official entry forms and accompanied by full payment.

E. RULES AND REGULATIONS OF COMPETITION

The competition will be run under the rules of FEI and rules of Equestrian Australia Federation and Equestrian Association of Malaysia (EAM). All riders receive prizes must be mounted.

Competition Ground

Indoor

The Organizer Reserves The Right To

Bill any participating club the cost of cleaning stables.

Alter advertised times if necessary.

Cancel any event or class.

Divide any class.

Refuse any entries.

Horses are only allowed to enter a total of 3 classes per day (jumping and dressage combined).

In House-Rules

All riders are expected to wear a correctly fastened and fitted hard hat, riding boots and shirt at all times when mounted.

The competition grounds and stable area must be kept clean and tidy at all times.

Washing down horses should be done in the washing bays only not inside the stables.

The dung/waste must be removed from the sawdust daily and disposed of in the correct manner. Stabling is limited and will be on a first paid first served basis.

All stabling must be left in a clean tidy state otherwise a charge will be levied.

Horse Passport / Vaccination Certificate

Passport must be available upon entry in to the showground. It is mandatory for the horses / ponies competing to be inoculated against Equine Influenza and Japanese B Virus. The medical record must indicate proper inoculations and clearance. If this conditions are not complied it; the horses / ponies will be denied access to the showground and competition.

Insurance

All participants must have personal accident insurance and third party liability insurance.

Entry Fees

All entry fees and stable fee must be paid prior to the start of the competition.

Late entry will be charged double. No refund will be made for cancellations without a veterinary certificate.

Stable

All horses will stables at temporary stable. No refund for the stable fee and will be charged if do not turn up. The size of temporary stable is $(3.3m \times 3.3m)$, as approved by FEI. All stable fee is non refundable.

Electrical

For the fire prevention and safety, extension of cable, plug points and electrical equipment by horse are not is allowed. All additional plugs and electrical extension must be approve and carried out by the licensed electricians and approve by OC.

Waiver Forms and Acknowledgement Forms

Please return all waiver and acknowledgement forms by Entries Closing Date. Competitors without signed forms will not be allowed to compete. The waiver and acknowledgement forms are attached as *Appendix 3.*

Prize Giving Ceremony

Show jumping placed riders that do not attend the prize giving ceremony will not receive their prizes. All riders must be in correct competition attire and mounted during prize giving.

Veterinary Scratching

Entries canceled after the Entries closing Date must be verified with a Veterinary medical Certificate for a 50% refund of the entry fee, provided that the cancellation is done before the commencement of any event.

Medical Control Programme

The executive committee of Equestrian Association of Malaysia (EAM) has decided that Usains Boimics Laboratory Services Sdn Bhd is the official laboratory to test all Equine Anti-Doping in the National level. Participants who refuse to allow their horses to be tested will be disqualified and disciplinary action will be taken. A horse subjected to MCP must follow instructions and be escorted by the steward to the MCP box. Any objections to MCP testing will penalize by EAM/ FEI.

SHOW IUMPING

Class 40cm - 60cm

This class 40-60cm open to the riders and horses that never compete in the jumping competition. Those combination (horse and rider) had participated at 80cm and above from January 2025 are not allow to participate in this class

Body Protector Jumping

Those riders under the age of 16yo from January 2025 is compulsory to wear body protector during warm up and competition.

FEI JUMPING WORLD CHALLENGE

The aim of the FEI World Challenge series is to offer athletes who, under normal circumstances, cannot take part in international competitions due to various factors (travel cost and distances for example), the opportunity to compete internationally without having to leave their own country. These "hybrid" competitions are meant as a bridge between the National and first International level of competition and are meant to help NFs develop the various disciplines in their country. FEI World Challenges exist in Jumping, Dressage, Eventing, Vaulting, Driving and Para Dressage.

The Competition is currently divided into ten geographical Zones. It offers the following categories of one age group:

Category A: 1.20-1.30 m
Category B: 1.10-1.20 m
Category C: 1.00-1.10 m

Individual Classification:

The FEI Jumping World Challenge offers an Individual classification per Country, per geographical Zone and per Category.

Team Classification:

The FEI Jumping World Challenge offers a Team classification per geographical Zone.

In All Fairness:

The riders of the FEI Jumping World Challenge are competing over the same courses using the same arena size (65 x 45 m) and designed by a Course Designer appointed by the FEI.

Development of the Sport

The FEI Jumping World Challenge also serves as an educational purpose by linking the competition with the coaching. The technical aspects of the courses are in correlation with the Levels 1 and 2 of the FEI Coach Education System, which is implemented in the same NFs that participate in the FEI Jumping World Challenge. The FEI Jumping World Challenge is held between the 1 January and the 31 December.

DRESSAGE

From Preliminary level and above, there will be no sharing of horses at official EAM Competitions. Must only enter and compete in two consecutive levels per event from the current grading; e. g. Graded Preliminary - can enter Preliminary and Novice or Preparatory & Preliminary - can enter Novice and Elementary

Prize money will only be awarded to score of 60% and above.
