A. COMPETITION SCHEDULE & DESCRIPTION

Late entries will be charged an additional 50% unless otherwise stated in the schedule.

B. PAYMENT OF ENTRIES

- Entry must be made on the official Entry Form.
- Stable bookings must be submitted together with the Stable Form.
- Entries will only be confirmed upon receipt of full payment.
- Failure to pay entry fees may result in disqualification

C. GENERAL CONDITION

- The competition will be conducted under the Rules and Regulations of EAM and FEI (where applicable).
- All participants must comply with the Organizing Committee's rules and safety requirements.
- Only fully paid entries will be accepted.
- The Organizer reserves the right to amend the schedule if necessary.

D. GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS

The competition will be conducted under the Rules and Regulations of the FEI, Equestrian Australia, and the Equestrian Association of Malaysia (EAM).

All riders receiving prizes must be mounted and properly attired during the prize-giving ceremony.

COMPETITION GROUND : Outdoor

THE ORGANIZER RESERVES THE RIGHT TO

- Bill any participating club for the cost of cleaning stables where necessary.
- Alter advertised times if required.
- Cancel any event or class.
- Divide any class.
- Refuse any entry without assigning any reason.

Horses are only allowed to enter a maximum of **three (3) classes per day** (combine Show Jumping and Dressage).

IN HOUSE RULES

- All riders must wear a properly fastened and fitted hard hat, riding boots and appropriate riding attire at all times when mounted inspecting the course.
- The competition grounds and stable area must be kept clean and tidy at all times.
- Washing of horses is only permitted in designated washing bays and strictly prohibited inside the stables.
- Dung and waste must be removed from the sawdust daily and disposed of appropriately.
- Stabling is limited and allocated on a **first paid, first served basis**.
- All stable must be left in a clean and tidy condition otherwise, cleaning charges will be imposed.

HORSE PASSPORT & VACCINATION CERTIFICATE

- Horse passport must be presented upon entry to the showground.
- It is mandatory for all competing horses/ponies to be vaccinated against **Equine Influenza and Japanese B Virus**.
- Medical record must clearly indicate valid inoculations and clearance.
- Failure to comply will result in denial of entry to the showground and competition.

INSURANCE

All participants must possess valid:

- Personal Accident Insurance
- Third Party Liability Insurance

ENTRY FEES

- All entry and stable fees must be fully paid prior to the commencement of the competition.
- Late entry will be charged double the entry fee.
- No refund will be made for cancellations without a valid veterinary medical certificate.

CSI1* CLASSES

For CSI1* classes:

- All horses and riders must be registered with the FEI and possess a valid FEI ID number.
- All CSI1* horses and riders must download the FEI Horse App and update the horse's temperature daily from three (3) days before the competition until the horse leaves the competition stable.
- Failure to update temperature records in the FEI Horse App may result in fines and/or suspension from FEI competitions.

STABLING

- All horses, including national entries, will be stabled in temporary stables (3.3m x 3.3m), approved by FEI standards.
- Stable fees are strictly non-refundable.
- Stable fees will be charged even if the horse does not turn up.

ELECTRICAL

For fire prevention and safety reasons:

- No extension cables, plug points, or electrical equipment may be installed by horse owners without approval from the Organizing Committee (OC).
- Any additional electrical installation must be approved and carried out by licensed electricians authorized by the OC.

WAIVER & ACKNOWLEDGEMENT FORMS

All Waiver and Acknowledgement Forms must be submitted by the Entries Closing Date. Competitors who fail to submit duly signed forms will not be permitted to compete. The Waiver and Acknowledgement Forms are attached as Appendix 3.

PRIZE GIVING CEREMONY

- Show Jumping placed riders who do not attend the prize giving ceremony will forfeit their prizes.
- All riders must be mounted and dressed in correct competition attire during the prize giving ceremony.

VETERINARY SCRATCHING

Entries cancelled after the Closing Date must be supported by a valid Veterinary Medical Certificate to be eligible for a 50% refund of the entry fee, provided the cancellation is made before the commencement of any event.

MEDICAL CONTROL PROGRAMME (MCP)

The Executive Committee of the Equestrian Association of Malaysia (EAM) has appointed Usains Biomics Laboratory Services Sdn Bhd as the official laboratory for Equine Anti-Doping testing at National level competitions.

- Any participant who refuses to allow their horse to be tested will be disqualified and disciplinary action will be taken.
- Horses selected for MCP must follow all instructions and be escorted by the steward to the designated MCP box.
- Any objection to MCP testing will result in penalties imposed by EAM and/or FEI.

SHOW JUMPING

Class ground poles and 40-60cm open only 2 riders and horses that have never competed in any jumping competitions.

Any horse-and-rider combination that has competed at 80cm and above from January 2025 onwards is not eligible to participate in this class.

Team Competition:

The Team Competition will be conducted under Article 220.2.1.1.

- Three (3) riders per team.
- All three penalty will count towards the team ranking.
- An eliminated rider will receive 20 penalty points plus the worst penalty score and time in that round, which will be added to the team's total score.

Body Protector (Show Jumping)

Riders under the age of **16 years old (from January 2025)** are required to wear a body protector during warm-up and competition.

DRESSAGE

Prize money will only be awarded to riders who achieve a score of 60% and above.

- From Preliminary level and above, sharing of horses is not permitted at official EAM competitions.
- Riders may only enter and compete in **two consecutive levels per event** according to their current grading.

Examples:

- Graded Preliminary → May enter Preparatory & Preliminary OR Preliminary & Novice
- Graded Novice → May enter Novice & Elementary

A horse graded Novice may not compete in Preliminary or Preparatory classes.

A horse may not compete below its graded level.
