B. ENTRIES CLOSING DATE

All entries must be made using the prescribed forms attached. Entries must reach the Organizer's Address as above by the **15 May 2026**.

Entries received after the above dates will be considered as Late Entries. Entries and booking of stables may be made in person, by post or via internet and will be confirmed when full payment is received.

All entries received after the closing date will be charged an additional 50% unless stated in the schedule.

C. ENTRY FORMS

All entries are to be on the official entry forms and accompanied by full payment. Attached as **Appendix 1** and **Appendix 2**. Please fill out the Entry Form and Stable Form and return to the above address before **15 May 2026**.

D. PAYMENT OF ENTRIES

E. RULES AND REGULATIONS OF COMPETITION

The competition will be run under the rules of FEI and rules of **Equestrian Australia Federation and Equestrian Association of Malaysia (EAM)**. All riders receive prizes must be mounted.

Competition Ground

Outdoor

The Organizer Reserves the Right To

- Bill any participating club the cost of cleaning stables.
- Alter advertised times if necessary.
- Cancel any event or class.
- Divide any class.
- Refuse any entries.

Grading System

Application for up / down grading must be made to the EAM before entries closing date.

Prize Giving Ceremony

Show jumping placed riders that do not attend the prize giving ceremony will not receive their prizes.

All riders must be mounted during prize giving.

Entry Fee

All entry fee and stabling fee must be paid prior to the start of the competition.

Late entries will be charged double. No refunds will be made for riders who cancel the entries without veterinary certificate.

Stable

All horses will be stabled at permanent stables. No refunds for the stabling fee and riders will be charged if they do not turn up.

Waiver Forms and Acknowledgement Forms

Please return all waiver and acknowledgement forms by Entries Closing Date. Competitors without signed forms will not be allowed to compete. The waiver and acknowledgement forms are attached as **Appendix 3**.

Horse Passport / Vaccination Certificate

Photos of the vaccination page in the passport needs to be sent in with your entries – [WhatsApp message to 012-263 2306 \(Show Secretariat\)](#): horse details page & vaccination pages. It is mandatory for horses / ponies competing to be inoculated against Equine Influenza (EI) and Japanese B Virus. The medical records must indicate proper inoculations and clearance. If these conditions are not complied with, the horses / ponies will be denied entry into the compound and competition/asked to leave.

Veterinary Scratching

Entries cancelled after the closing date must be verified with a Veterinary medical Certificate for a 50% refund of the entry fee, provided that the cancellation is done before the commencement of any event.

Jumping Event (Class 40cm - 60cm)

This class is open to riders and horses that have never compete in a jumping competition. The combination (horse and rider) that have participated at 80cm and above from January 2024 are not allow to participate in this class.

Overall Championship Prize

LTM SMALL TOUR : SJ3-SJ17-SJ21

PRTC MEDIUM TOUR : SJ4-SJ18-SJ22

PENP BIG TOUR : SJ5-SJ19-SJ23

Riders will have to join all 3 classes of each tour to win the overall championship prize of the particular category.

6 bar

Restricted to riders that have not jumped above 1.10m in the last 2 years

Body Protector Jumping

It is compulsory to wear body protector during warm up and competition, for those riders under the age of 16 years old in the year 2026.

How to Compete

Gear, Dress & Presentation

Clean, neat and appropriate tack. Helmets must have a safety harness. Matching mini chaps and boots may be worn instead of long boots. The presentation mark for riders is judged as they enter the arena and await the bell. Neatness is the first requirement. The mark is for overall impression of a well-groomed rider on a well-turned-out horse with correctly fitted and clean gear. Whips and spurs are optional. **Gloves and plaiting are NOT compulsory but will count towards presentation mark.**

Check Course Plan And/Or Test

Be aware of judging requirements and mandatory lines.

Walk Course

This is encouraged, but not compulsory.

ENTER in working trot or a 2-point / 3-point canter.

PROCEED to the Judge – Halt and salute.

PREPARE with a 2-point or 3-point canter circle and wait for the bell.

FINISH with a circle at the end of the round and a smooth downward transition from a 2-point or 3-point canter position and trot out.

COLLECT score sheet after official results are published.

Rules

1. Penalties

The following penalties apply and are deducted from the score:

1st disobedience	8
2nd disobedience	8
3rd disobedience	Elimination
Knock down	8
1st fall of horse and/or rider	Elimination

Judging Criteria: Correct Technique

1. Rider position
2. Legs
3. Eyes
4. Seat Position – 2-point & 3-point
5. Hands - Releases

Dressage

Enter and compete in no more than 3 tests in same day.

From Novice level and above, there will be no sharing of horses.

Must only enter and compete in two consecutive levels per event from the current grading; graded Prelim - can enter Prelim and Novice or Novice and Elementary. Graded Novice - can enter Novice and Elementary or Elementary and Medium.

Prize money only awarded to the riders score with 60% and above (**from Preparatory till Novice classes**).

Electrical

For fire prevention and safety, no extension cables, plug points and electrical equipments to be used by horse owners without the prior approval from the OC. All additional plugs and electrical extensions must be approved and work carried out by the licensed electricians.

Insurance

All participants must have personal accident insurance and third-party liability insurance.

Medical Control Programme

Random urine testing of horses / ponies for prohibited substances may be conducted if advised by the Official Treating Veterinarian. The participants refusal to allow their horses to be tested will result in them being disqualified and discipline action will be taken

A horse subjected to MCP must follow the instruction and escorted by the steward to the MCP box. Any objection for MCP test will result in the horse and rider being penalize by the Organizer, National Federation and Federation Equestre Internationale.

F. IN-HOUSE RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Helmets are **MANDATORY** while mounted.
- Kindly park your floats at the designated float parking area. Our Security personnel are available to direct you to the appropriate area.
- Floats will only be allowed to enter PRTC Stables from 10am - 6pm. If your float arrives after the given times, please contact the stable supervisor so that arrangements can be made.
- Floats are strictly not allowed into the club premises between the hours of 6am-10am.
- Vehicles are only allowed inside for loading / unloading of equipments. However, prior approval must be sort from the PRTC security department. Therefore, you are required to inform the secretariat upon arrival, so that arrangements can be made.
- All riders, visitors, grooms etc with vehicles are required to park their vehicles at Carpark B or across the road. You can get directions from the secreteriat.
- All **GRASS** tracks are **STRICTLY OFF LIMITS** to all Equestrian Horses at all times.
- Lunging is only allowed in lunging rings and wooden bull ring. Lunging is not allowed in arenas.
- All riders are required to wear a correctly fastened and fitted hard hat, riding boots and shirt at all times when mounted.
- The competition grounds and stable area must be kept clean and tidy at all times.
- Washing down horses should be done in the washing bays only not inside the stables.
- You are provided with bags for the disposal of dung and other refuse.
- The dung/waste must be removed from the sawdust daily and disposed off in the correct manner.
- All stable must be left in a clean tidy state otherwise a charge will be levied.
- Please be informed that all horses and ponies intending to participate in this competition will be required to be immunized (up to date primary vaccines as well as booster doses) against the following:

Equine Influenza (EI)
Japanese B Encephalitis (Jap B)
